### The Nevada State Health Division Launches New Locator Website for the H1N1 Flu Vaccine

Carson City – The Nevada State Health Division today launched the new H1N1 flu vaccine locator tool on <http://health.nv.gov> and <http://flu.nv.gov>. County by county information will be accessible on this website.

“Due to the limited quantity of vaccine available, there hasn’t been any public H1N1 flu clinics scheduled for people that are in the target groups,” said Dr. Tracey Green, State Health Officer. “We anticipate having enough vaccine to have larger vaccination clinics for H1N1 by November. Keep checking back at the flu locator link, as this website will be updated frequently.”

The Health Division is partnering with the local health authorities and community stakeholders in order to receive comprehensive information that can be placed in a central location for the public.


As a reminder, people can also sign up on the ListServ, located at [flu.nv.gov](http://flu.nv.gov), in the media box. ListServ participants will receive updated information in a timely manner.

Knowing that it may take a few weeks in order for people to receive their H1N1 flu vaccination, there are some easy ways to protect themselves and their families:

- Get your seasonal flu vaccination.
- Cough or sneeze into your sleeve.
- Wash your hands often with soap and water, especially after you cough or sneeze. Alcohol-based hand cleaners are also effective.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose or mouth. Germs spread this way.
- Try to avoid close contact with sick people.
- If you get sick with the flu, stay home from work or school and limit contact with others to keep from infecting them.
